

Feng Pao Hsii Education Award

Professor Feng Pao Hsii (1936-2015) was a pioneering figure in Singapore rheumatology who established the first department of rheumatology in our country. In recognition of his contributions and in honour of his memory, the Singapore Society of Rheumatology (SSR) has inaugurated an education award in his name. The Education Award seeks to recognise and support Singapore trainee rheumatologists for research work presented or accepted at regional or international conferences.

Terms of reference

1. Applications are open to Rheumatology trainees in Singapore (Senior Residents) who have presented an abstract or have had an abstract accepted at a reputable regional or international conference within the application period.
2. Eligible abstracts should have been presented at a conference OR accepted for a conference from 1 July of the preceding year to 30 June of the current year. The closing date for applications is 30 June each year.
3. The applicant must be the main presenter of the abstract.
4. All other forms of sponsorship by external parties or other sources MUST be declared on the application form.
5. Applicants must be in active service in rheumatology (e.g. not on no-pay leave) during the period of the conference.
6. Applicants must be SSR members who have actively participated in SSR activities.
7. A supporting letter from the applicant's respective Programme Director (PD) and Head of Division/Department (HOD) is required.
8. A sum of SGD\$3000 per calendar year has been allocated, to support a maximum of 3 awardees per year. The maximum amount awarded to an individual trainee is capped at SGD \$1500.
 - a. Top awardee \$1500, 2nd awardee \$1000, 3rd awardee \$500
9. Applicant to submit completed application form with the necessary supporting documents to the SSR Secretariat at rheumatology.ssr@gmail.com
10. The SSR Executive Committee will appoint a subcommittee to assess every application in a blinded manner.
11. All decisions are final.
12. Awardees will be announced during the SSR Annual General Meeting.
13. The SSR reserves the right to discontinue this program at any time without explanation.
